

Balázs Szegedy is a Hungarian mathematician whose research concerns combinatorics and graph theory. Szegedy earned a master's degree in 1998 and a PhD in 2003 from Eötvös Loránd University in Budapest. His dissertation, supervised by Péter Pál Pálffy, was about group theory and was entitled “On the Sylow and Borel subgroups of classical groups”. After temporary positions at the Al-fréd Rényi Institute of Mathematics, Microsoft Research, and the Institute for Advanced Study, he joined the faculty of the University of Toronto Scarborough in 2006. He returned to the Rényi Institute in 2013. Balázs Szegedy is Member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences.
